



IRVING FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT BOARD ANNOUNCES NEW APPOINTMENTS

Doug Stephan appointed to board of directors, Chris Calvery elected board president

IRVING, Texas (February 27, 2017) – The Irving Flood Control District Section III (IFCD 3) board of directors announced its latest personnel updates following recent appointments by the Irving City Council. During its meeting on Feb. 2, the Council reappointed Chris Calvery and Dr. Mazhar Islamraja to the board for second terms and appointed Doug Stephan to the vacant board seat.

Doug Stephan has been a resident of Valley Ranch for 24 years and has actively volunteered in the community. He is currently on the Elementary Facilities Committee for Coppell ISD and serves as the president of the Valley Ranch Elementary Dad's Club. Previously, Stephan was president of The Oaks of Valley Ranch HOA and a member of the Valley Ranch Master Association – Public Safety Committee. He is the owner and founder of Empower Decision Systems, Inc.

Once appointed and confirmed by the Irving City Council, the board members voted to elect Chris Calvery as the organization's new president during their monthly board meeting on Feb. 20. The board also elected William Correa as vice president, Neha Kunte as secretary and Mazhar Islamraja as treasurer.

"I'm honored to continue to serve the Valley Ranch Community by stepping into the role of IFCD 3 board president," said Calvery. "We're excited to welcome Doug Stephan to the board and eager to hit the ground running with our 2017 projects."

Chris Calvery has served the IFCD 3 Board in various capacities since 2008, but most recently held the role of vice president. He is the director of implementations and project management for WEB-TPA, a third-party administrator in the health insurance industry. A native of Irving, Calvery has served on several local boards, including the Irving Symphony Orchestra Association.

IFCD 3 is governed by a five-member board appointed by the Irving City Council. Members serve staggered two-year terms. The board is a citizen-led, professionally managed and community-centric agency committed to efficiency, effectiveness and transparency.

Next month's board meeting will take place on March 20 at 6:30 p.m. at the Valley Ranch Association offices, 8830 N MacArthur Blvd in Irving.
